# A short guide to using the WME script and the Management WebApp

# Part #1 - The WME Script



### The CIFP script


Purpose: To insert closures into a database to be sent to Waze via JSON Feed.

NOTE: The use of CIFP must be authorized, so the script requires an API key to be used. If you do not have one, ask your country manager who, at his discretion, will generate one.


### Installation

- Make sure you have the "TamperMonkey" extension installed by downloading it from here: <a href="https://www.tampermonkey.net/">https://www.tampermonkey.net/</a>
- Download the script from the Waze. Tools CODE site by following this link: <a href="https://code.waze.tools/home/browse.jsp?ShowSID=9ef6797a-6358-4b31-8147-511099e3419f">https://code.waze.tools/home/browse.jsp?ShowSID=9ef6797a-6358-4b31-8147-511099e3419f</a>
- TamperMonkey will ask you to install the script, accept
- Once WME is launched an additional icon called "CIFP" will appear at the top


- Follow the instructions in the previous slide for installation
- If everything went well, you will have a new button labeled CIFP in your WME
- If the button does not appear, refer to the last slide of this section to enable debugging and generate useful information to solve the problem




- Select the segments that should be closed
- Multiple segments can be selected by holding down the CTRL key while clicking on the desired segment
- You can only select objects of type "segment", other object types are not supported.




- After selection, click on the CIFP button
- A window like the one on the side will appear
- If this is your first time using CIFP click on the button with the key per to enter your API key
- Check that the number of segments matches the number of segments to close
- Submit the form




- Wait a couple of seconds while the Waze.Tools CIFP server processes your request
- Once processed, a box will appear containing the result of the operation
- Please note that if the API key is null or invalid, the operation will never be successful



- If the request has been correctly registered, the box you see here on the side will appear
- In the box you will find the ID assigned to this closing group; click on it to enter the details
- You will be transferred to the CIFP WebApp in EDIT mode (see the "Editing an Orphan Closure" slide below)



- If the entry has not been recorded in the database, the box you see here will appear
- In the box you will find a general explanation of why the insertion was not successful
- In most cases, further information about the error encountered will be available in the browser console (F12)



### What to do in case of errors



- In case of error, it might be useful to display some additional messages
- To generate these details, open the script in TamperMonkey and edit the WCIFP\_DEBUG line, changing the value from "false" to "true"
- The results can be seen from the browser console (F12)

# Part #2 - The WebApp



### The CIFP Web Application

Purpose: To manage the closures that will generate the feed to be sent to Waze

### **Entry point**

The Web application is available from here: <a href="https://cifp.waze.tools/">https://cifp.waze.tools/</a>

### **Notes**

- To use this application, authorization to use is required
- Authorization to use is given by an admin<sup>(\*)</sup> and is related to the selected country
- Each user can be authorized for one or more countries

(\*) The admin of a country is usually the country manager or a high-level user selected by the country manager

### **Entry point**

- Once connected to the CIFP site, the home page visible here on the right is displayed
- To enter, click on the image
- To be able to log in, you will need your credentials to be enabled for this job
- If not, ask your country administrator



### **Authentication**

- The CIFP application requires the user to be verified and have the necessary rights to access
- Enter username and password to continue
- Credentials must match those registered in the AUTH webapp and MUST have been enabled for CIFP access by an admin



### **Queries Home**

- Once you enter, you will find yourself on the main page of available queries
- Here are four possible queries:
  - Active Closures
  - Paused Closures
  - Orphan Closures
  - Map of all Closures
- Additionally, you will find the "freshness" of the update from Waze below.



### **Active closures**



- A closure is considered "active" when it is saved and sent to the JSON feed
- The list displays the closures that are relevant to the user
- Clicking on the description switches to edit mode
- Clicking on "Seg/Str" displays a summary of the roads involved






### **Active closures options**

- The list displays the closures that are relevant to the user
- Clicking on the description switches to edit mode
- Clicking on "Seg/Str" displays a summary of the roads involved



### Paused closures options




- You can filter the list based on four parameters:
- The Country
  - o This is not editable
- The display order
  - By location, creation date, last update, etc
- The period
  - This month, last month, last year, etc


### Incomplete street names

- By clicking on the value of the "Seg/Str" column, the summary of the roads involved in the closure will appear
- If the second digit has a red background it means that some roads have no name, and since Waze does not accept roads without a name the closure cannot be activated



### **Orphan closures**


- A closure is "orphan" when some mandatory fields have not been filled in
- The line has a red background if it does not contain even one segment
- All closures in this status, if not modified by the end of the day, will be treated as an entry error, and deleted at 00:00 GMT




- You can filter the list based on four parameters:
- The Country
  - o This is not editable
- The display order
  - By location, creation date, last update, etc
- The period
  - This month, last month, last year, etc
- Who created it
  - All editors or a specific one



# Map view


- Closures displayed on the map are identified with a different icon for each closure type
- Icon color meaning:
  - Red: active
  - o Gray: paused
  - Yellow: orphaned
- By clicking on a closure icon you will be redirected to the management page for that closure



# Map view options




- You can filter the icons based on two parameters:
- The closure type
  - o All
  - Road closed
  - Accident
- The closure status
  - o All
  - Active
  - Paused
  - Orphan




# Editing an "orphan" closure

- A newly entered closure is initially in the "orphan" status
- All closures in the "orphan" status, if not modified by the end of the day, will be treated as an entry error, and deleted at 00:00 GMT
- A valid closure must have at least:
  - Description
  - Type & SubType
  - Start & End Date/Time



# Enter all the necessary data


- As mentioned in the previous slide, you must enter all the mandatory data
- If the closure is not "continuous" over time but is fragmented into daily periods, also fill in the "Schedule Table"
- Don't forget the flag that indicates what to do with this closure when it expires.



### Confirm and activate the closure




- As you can see from the previous slide, each change made to the closure puts it in "paused" status to prevent partial and false closures from being published in the JSON feed
- To enable the closure and insert it in the feed simply click on the "Save & Activate" button



### Other actions available




- As you may have noticed, there are three more buttons:
  - Bookmark This
     Save the closure in a list for later reference
  - Edit Segments
     Calls the WME with the segments of this closure pre-selected, allowing you to modify them and, once saved, update the closure on the CIFP side
  - Delete Forever
     Permanently remove the closure from the database and from the JSON feed



### The left side menu

- By clicking on the "≡" icon at the top left, the application menu will appear
- Here you can find the link to some of the less used functions, such as:
  - Bookmarks
  - Statistics
  - API Documentation
  - General Settings
  - Issue tracker (bugs)
  - Logout



### **Bookmarks**

- Any bookmarked closure can be quickly retrieved from here
- To the right of the description are two icons:

  - □ [DELETE]
     To delete this closure from bookmarks


### **Statistics**

  - The alert functions via Slack are not yet active
